Faculty, Staff, Students

Academic Freedom and Faculty Rights Committee

[for faculty]

Considers faculty grievances and alleged violations of academic freedom and, when necessary forwards faculty grievances to the Consolidated Hearing Committee for formal hearings.

Consolidated Hearing Committee (CHC)

The Consolidate Hearing Committee (CHC) is the hearing body for grievances and complaints brought against faculty members (as defined in PPM 8-12.1(3)) at the University of Utah or by faculty members asserting rights including appeals from retention, promotion and tenure decisions. Reports to the Academic Senate.

Employment and Discrimination Complaints Hearing Panel

[for faculty, staff, students]

Conducts formal hearing regarding staff employment grievances. Also conducts formal hearings on complaints from faculty, staff members, or students charging improper discrimination based upon race, color, ethnic, national origin, sex, religion, age, lack of American citizenship, disability, or veteran status.

Student Behavior Committee

[for students]

Hears charges of students' alleged violations of Standards of Behavior, except for offenses which are delegated from time to time to other committees by explicit action of the Board of Trustees.

Charges of student academic misconduct are heard by each College's Academic Misconduct Committee.
